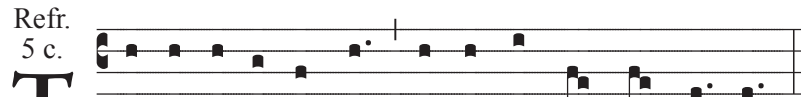
Psalm 138
