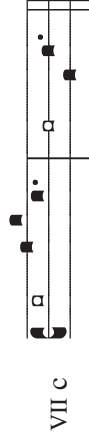

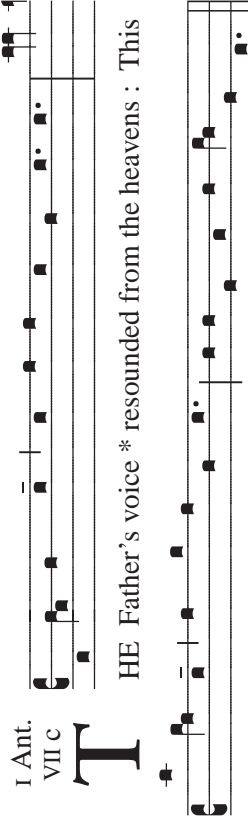

listen to what he says *to you*.

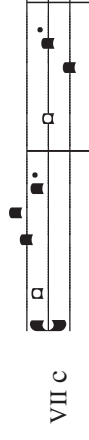
All : The Father's voice resounded *from the heavens* : *

Psalm I



The cantor begins and alternates verses with the congregation :

Psalm 110 : 1-5. 7

1. The Lord's revelation to my Master : /
"Sit on my **right** : *
yours foes I will put beneath **your feet** ."
2. The Lord will wield from Zion your scepter of **power** : *
rule in the midst of all **your foes** .
3. A prince from the day of your birth on the **holy mountains** ; *
from the womb before the dawn I **begot** you.
4. The Lord has sworn an oath he will not change. /
"You are a **priest for ever**, *
a priest like Melchizedek of **old** ."
5. The Master standing at **your right** hand *
will shatter kings on the day of his **great wrath** .
6. He shall drink from the stream *by the wayside* *
and therefore he shall lift up **his head** .
7. Glory to the Father, and *to the Son*, *
and to the **Holy Spirit** :
8. as it was in the beginning, *is now*, *
and will be for ever. **Amen** .
