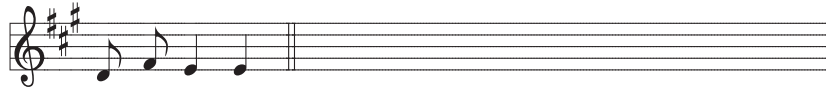
Eccus 15:3-4; Psalm 104

and your life is hidden with *Christ in God*. (R̥)

When Christ, who is our *life appears*, *
then you also will appear with *him in glory*. (R̥)

Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, /
to which indeed *you were called*, *
in *the one body*. (R̥)

Let the word of God dwell *in you richly*, *
as you sing psalms, and hymns, / and *spiritual songs*. (R̥)

Whatever you do in *word or deed*, *
do everything in the Name of the Lord *Jesus Christ*. (R̥)
