





PRAYER BEFORE THE DIVINE OFFICE

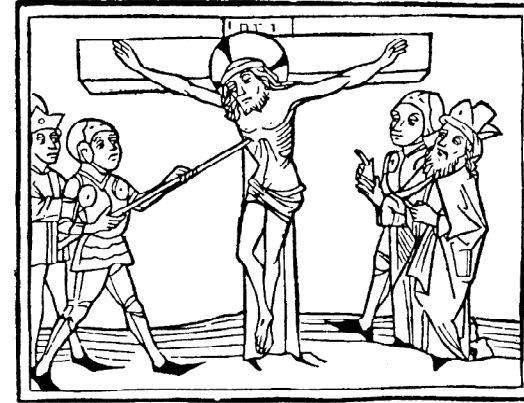
