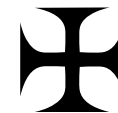

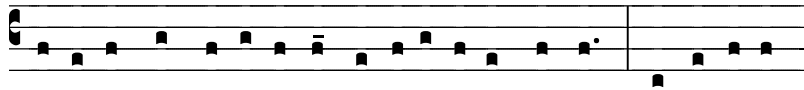

Those who were filled with pow'r divine.

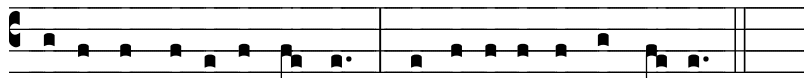
