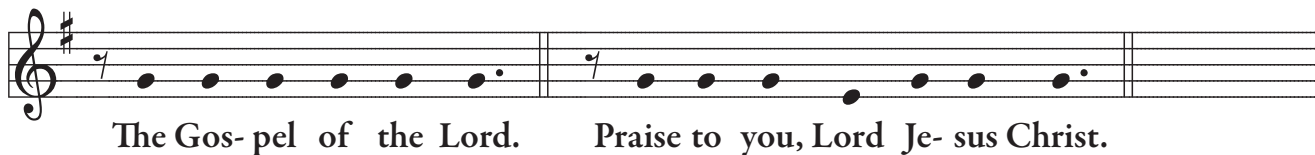
## Pentecost Sunday [A]
